- 9 SECTION 2. Section 21.165(a)(1), Penal Code, is amended to

- 11 (1) "Deep fake media [video]" means a visual depiction
- 12 [a video,] created or altered through [with] the use of software,
- 13 <u>machine learning</u>, <u>artificial intelligence</u>, <u>or any other</u>
- 14 computer-generated or technological means, including by adapting,
- 15 modifying, manipulating, or altering an authentic visual depiction
- 16 manually or through an automated process [intent to deceive], that
- 17 appears to a reasonable person to depict a real person,
- 18 indistinguishable from an authentic visual depiction of the real
- 19 person, performing an action that did not occur in reality.
- SECTION 3. Section 21.165(b), Penal Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (b) A person commits an offense if, without the effective
- 23 consent of the person appearing to be depicted, the person
- 24 knowingly produces or distributes by electronic means [a] deep fake

- 1 media [video] that appears to depict the person with the person's
- 2 intimate parts exposed or engaged in sexual conduct.
- 3 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 4 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 10 before that date.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
