## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the authority of a property owners' association to

3 assess a fine for discolored vegetation or turf during a period of

- 4 residential watering restriction.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Section 202.008 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 202.008. LIMITATION ON FINES DURING RESIDENTIAL WATER
- 9 RESTRICTION. (a) For the purposes of this section, "residential
- 10 <u>watering restriction" means a temporary restriction of water use to</u>
- 11 irrigate residential vegetation or turf that is mandated by a
- 12 municipality, water utility, or other wholesale or retail water
- 13 supplier as part of a strategy to conserve water during a period of
- 14 drought.

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- 15 (b) A property owners' association may not assess a fine
- 16 against a property owner for a violation of an applicable
- 17 restrictive covenant that requires the owner to maintain green
- 18 <u>vegetation or turf or prohibits discolored or brown vegetation or</u>
- 19 <u>turf on the property:</u>
- 20 (1) during a period when the owner's property is
- 21 subject to a residential watering restriction under which
- 22 discolored or brown vegetation or turf could reasonably result; and
- 23 (2) before the 30th day after the date a residential
- 24 watering restriction described by Subdivision (1) is lifted.
