2	relating to address information contained on reports of political
3	contributions and expenditures made available on the Internet by
4	the Texas Ethics Commission.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 254.036, Election Code, is amended by
7	adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
8	(b-1) In prescribing the format of a report filed with the
9	commission under Subsection (b), the commission shall ensure the
10	report includes a space to indicate whether the address of an
11	individual listed as having received a political expenditure is a
12	residence address.
13	SECTION 2. Section 254.0401, Election Code, is amended by
14	amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-2) to read as
15	follows:
16	(e) Before making a report filed under Section 254.036(b)
17	available on the Internet, the commission shall remove each
18	portion, other than city, state, and zip code, of $\underline{\cdot}$
19	(1) the address of a person listed as having made a
20	political contribution to the person filing the report; and
21	(2) the residence address of an individual listed as
22	having received a political expenditure if the individual's address

is indicated in the space described by Section 254.036(b-1) as

- 1 remain available on the report maintained in the commission's
- 2 office but may not be available electronically at that office.
- 3 (e-2) The address information the commission removes under
- 4 Subsection (e) must remain available on the report maintained in
- 5 the commission's office but may not be available electronically at
- 6 that office.
- 7 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 8 a report of political contributions and expenditures under Chapter
- 9 254, Election Code, that is required to be filed on or after January
- 10 1, 2026.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
