9	commission under Subsection (b), the commission shall ensure the
10	report includes a space to indicate whether the address of ar
11	individual listed as having received a political expenditure is a
12	residence address.
13	SECTION 2. Section 254.0401, Election Code, is amended by
14	amending Subsection (e) and adding Subsection (e-1) to read as
15	follows:
16	(e) Before making a report filed under Section 254.036(b)
17	available on the Internet, the commission shall remove each
18	portion, other than city, state, and zip code, of:
19	$\underline{(1)}$ the address of a person listed as having made a
20	political contribution to the person filing the report; and

- 5 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 6 a report of political contributions and expenditures under Chapter
- 7 254, Election Code, that is required to be filed on or after January
- 8 1, 2026.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
