2	relating to the sale of fireworks on and before the Juneteenth
3	holiday.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks
8	permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during
9	periods:
10	(1) beginning June 14 and ending at midnight on June 19
11	in a county in which the commissioners court of the county has
12	approved the sale of fireworks during the period;
13	(2) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4;
14	(3) $[(2)]$ beginning December 20 and ending at midnight
15	on January 1 of the following year; and
16	(4) [(3)] beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on
17	May 5 if the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than
18	100 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in
19	which the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of
20	fireworks during the period.
21	SECTION 2. Sections 352.051(b) and (d), Local Government
22	Code, are amended to read as follows:
23	(b)(1) The Texas A&M Forest Service in the ordinary course
24	of its activities shall determine whether drought conditions, as

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defined under Subsection (a)(2), exist on average in any county 1 requesting such a determination. The Texas A&M Forest Service 2 3 shall make available the measurement index guidelines used to determine whether drought conditions exist in a particular area. 4 5 Following any determination that such drought conditions exist, the Texas A&M Forest Service shall notify said county or counties when 6 such drought conditions no longer exist. The Texas A&M Forest 7 8 Service shall make its services available each day during the Texas Independence Day, San Jacinto Day, Memorial Day, Juneteenth, Fourth 9 10 of July, Diwali, and December fireworks seasons to respond to the request of any county for a determination whether drought 11 12 conditions exist on average in the county.

13 (2) The Texas A&M Forest Service shall be allowed to
14 take such donations of equipment or funds as necessary to aid in the
15 carrying out of this section.

16 (d) To facilitate compliance with an order adopted under17 Subsection (c), the order must be adopted before:

18 (1) February 15 of each year for the Texas19 Independence Day fireworks season;

20 (2) April 1 of each year for the San Jacinto Day21 fireworks season;

(3) April 25 of each year for the Cinco de Mayo23 fireworks season;

24 (4) May 15 of each year for the Memorial Day fireworks25 season;

26 (5) June 1 of each year for the Juneteenth fireworks
27 season;

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1 (6) June 15 of each year for the Fourth of July fireworks season; 2 3 (7) [(6)] 15 days before the beginning of Diwali for 4 the Diwali fireworks season; and 5 (8) [(7)] December 15 of each year for each December 6 fireworks season. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8

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9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
