A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to a severance payment to a superintendent of a school
- 3 district.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.201(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) For purposes of this subsection, "severance payment"
- 8 means any amount paid by the board of trustees of an independent
- 9 school district or a board of managers appointed under Chapter 39A
- 10 to or in behalf of a superintendent on early termination of the
- 11 superintendent's contract that exceeds the amount earned by the
- 12 superintendent under the contract as of the date of termination,
- 13 including any amount that exceeds the amount of earned standard
- 14 salary and benefits that is paid as a condition of early termination
- 15 of the contract. The board of trustees or board of managers, as
- 16 applicable, may not make a severance payment to a superintendent in
- 17 an amount greater than six months' salary and benefits under the
- 18 superintendent's terminated contract. The board of trustees or
- 19 board of managers, as applicable, that makes a severance payment to
- 20 a superintendent shall report the terms of the severance payment to
- 21 the commissioner. The commissioner shall reduce the district's
- 22 Foundation School Program funds by any amount that the amount of the
- 23 severance payment to the superintendent exceeds an amount equal to
- 24 six months' [one year's] salary and benefits under the

- 1 superintendent's terminated contract. The commissioner may adopt
- 2 rules as necessary to administer this subsection.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 11.201(c), Education Code, as amended by
- 4 this Act, applies only to a severance payment made by the board of
- 5 trustees of an independent school district or board of managers
- 6 appointed under Chapter 39A, Education Code, to a superintendent
- 7 under an agreement entered into on or after the effective date of
- 8 this Act. A severance payment made by the board of trustees of an
- 9 independent school district or board of managers appointed under
- 10 Chapter 39A, Education Code, to a superintendent under an agreement
- 11 entered into before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 12 the law in effect at the time the agreement was made, and that law is
- 13 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
