- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0091 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 28.0091. ADVANCED PLACEMENT COURSE STANDARDS. (a) A
- 8 school district may offer an advanced placement course only if the
- 9 course complies with:
- 10 (1) the school laws of this state; and
- 11 (2) the essential knowledge and skills adopted by the
- 12 State Board of Education for the applicable subject area.
- 13 (b) The State Board of Education shall review each advanced
- 14 placement course offered by a school district to ensure compliance
- 15 with this section.
- SECTION 2. Section 28.023, Education Code, is amended by
- 17 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 18 <u>(a-1)</u> For purposes of this section, a board of trustees may
- 19 approve only an advanced placement examination that is for an
- 20 advanced placement course offered in accordance with Section
- 21 28.0091.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 23 school year.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
