1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the regulation of the practice of pharmacy.  
1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-21 SECTION 1. Section [562.0541](#)(d), Occupations Code, is  
1-22 amended to read as follows:  
1-23 (d) The quantity of an emergency refill of insulin may not  
1-24 exceed a 30-day supply unless the smallest commercially available  
1-25 package exceeds a 30-day supply. A pharmacist may dispense  
1-26 multiple packages of insulin for an emergency refill if the total  
1-27 quantity dispensed does not exceed a 30-day supply. The [quantity  
1-28 of an] emergency refill of insulin-related equipment or supplies  
1-29 may not exceed [the lesser of a 30-day supply or] the smallest  
1-30 commercially available package necessary for a 30-day supply.  
1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
