A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

# 1 AN ACT

2 relating to a requirement that certain water districts make audio  
3 and video recordings of open meetings available on the Internet.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 551.128, Government Code, is amended by  
6 amending Subsection (b-1) and adding Subsection (b-7) to read as  
7 follows:

17 (1) make a video and audio recording of reasonable  
18 quality of each:

19 (A) regularly scheduled open meeting that is not  
20 a work session or a special called meeting; and

21 (B) open meeting that is a work session or  
22 special called meeting if:

23 (i) the governmental body is an elected  
24 school district board of trustees for a school district that has a

1 student enrollment of 10,000 or more; and  
2 (ii) at the work session or special called  
3 meeting, the board of trustees votes on any matter or allows public  
4 comment or testimony; and

5 (2) make available an archived copy of the video and  
6 audio recording of each meeting described by Subdivision (1) on the  
7 Internet.

8 (b-7) A district subject to Chapter 36, 49, or 60, Water  
9 Code, no part of which is located in a county with a population of  
10 125,000 or more, shall:

11 (1) make an audio recording of reasonable quality of  
12 each regularly scheduled open meeting that is not a work session or  
13 a special called meeting; and

14 (2) make available an archived copy of the audio  
15 recording of each meeting described by Subdivision (1) on the  
16 Internet in the manner required by Subsections (b-3) and (b-4).

17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to  
18 an open meeting held on or after the effective date of this Act. An  
19 open meeting that is held before the effective date of this Act is  
20 governed by the law in effect on the date of the open meeting, and  
21 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
