- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 82.011, Family Code, is amended to read 5 as follows:
- Sec. 82.011. CONFIDENTIALITY OF CERTAIN INFORMATION. 7 On
- request by an applicant, the court \underline{shall} [\underline{may}] protect the 8
- applicant's mailing address and county of residence by rendering an 9
- order: 10
- requiring the applicant to: 11
- 12 (A) disclose the applicant's mailing address and
- county of residence to the court; 13
- 14 (B) designate a person to receive on behalf of
- the applicant any notice or documents filed with the court related 15
- to the application; and 16
- (C) disclose the designated person's mailing 17
- 18 address to the court;
- (2) requiring the court clerk to: 19
- 20 strike the applicant's mailing address and
- county of residence from the public records of the court, if 21
- applicable; and 22
- 23 (B) maintain a confidential record of
- 24 applicant's mailing address and county of residence for use only by

- 1 the court; and
- 2 (3) prohibiting the release of the information to the
- 3 respondent.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 85.007, Family Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) On request by a person protected by an order or an adult
- 8 member of the family or household of a person protected by an order,
- 9 the court shall [may] exclude from a protective order:
- 10 (1) the address, county of residence, and telephone
- 11 number of a person protected by the order; or
- 12 (2) the address and telephone number of:
- 13 (A) the place of employment or business of a
- 14 person protected by the order; or
- 15 (B) the child-care facility or school a child
- 16 protected by the order attends or in which the child resides.
- 17 (a-1) In a hearing on an application for a protective order,
- 18 the court shall inform each person described by Subsection (a) who
- 19 is present at the hearing of the person's right, on request, to have
- 20 <u>information</u> described by that subsection excluded from the
- 21 protective order and specifically ask the person if the person
- 22 wishes the court to exclude that information from the protective
- 23 order.
- SECTION 3. Section 87.004, Family Code, is amended by
- 25 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 26 <u>(a-1) On request by a person protected by an order, the</u>
- 27 court shall keep confidential the changed address or telephone

- 1 number in the notification described by Subsection (a). On
- 2 granting a request for confidentiality under this subsection, the
- 3 court shall order the clerk to maintain a confidential record of the
- 4 information as described by Section 85.007(b)(2) and exclude that
- 5 information from the notification. If the applicant seeks to keep
- 6 confidential the applicant's mailing address, the applicant must:
- 7 (1) disclose the applicant's mailing address and
- 8 county of residence to the court;
- 9 (2) designate a person to receive on behalf of the
- 10 applicant any notice or documents filed with the court related to
- 11 the order; and
- 12 (3) disclose the designated person's mailing address
- 13 to the court.
- 14 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to an
- 15 application for a protective order that is pending on or filed on or
- 16 after the effective date of this Act or a notification of change of
- 17 address or telephone number that is filed on or after the effective
- 18 date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
