## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a prohibition on funding for gender reassignment.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 10, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 2278 to read as follows:
6	Chapter 2278. Prohibition on Use of Taxpayer Resources
7	Sec. 2278.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Gender reassignment" means a medical
9	intervention, including surgery performed for the purpose of
10	altering a person's primary or secondary sex characteristics or
11	drugs or biologicals prescribed for the purpose of altering or
12	maintaining alteration of a person's primary or secondary sex
13	characteristics.
14	(2) "Intersex person" means an person who:
15	(A) has inborn chromosomal, gonadal, genital, or
16	endocrine characteristics, or a combination of those
17	characteristics, that are not suited to the typical definition of
18	male or female or are atypical for the determined sex of the person;
19	<u>or</u>
20	(B) is considered by a medical professional to
21	have inborn chromosomal, gonadal, genital, or endocrine
22	characteristics that are ambiguous or atypical for the determined
23	sex of the person.
24	Sec. 2278.002. PROHIBITION ON USE OF TAXPAYER RESOURCES FOR

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- 1 GENDER REASSIGNMENT. (a) No funds authorized or appropriated by
- 2 State law shall be expended for any gender reassignment.
- 3 (b) No funds authorized or appropriated by State law shall
- 4 be expended for health benefits that covers gender reassignment.
- 5 (c) The prohibition in subsection (a) and (b) does not apply
- 6 to gender reassignment to be performed on an intersex person.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
