A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to emergency cardiovascular care at public schools and

- 3 certain private schools in this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.902(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (c) Each school nurse, assistant school nurse, athletic
- 8 coach or sponsor, physical education instructor, marching band
- 9 director, cheerleading coach, and any other school employee
- 10 specified by the commissioner and each student who serves as an
- 11 athletic trainer must participate in the instruction in the use of
- 12 an automated external defibrillator. A person described by this
- 13 subsection must receive and maintain certification in the use of an
- 14 automated external defibrillator from the American Heart
- 15 Association, the American Red Cross, or a similar nationally
- 16 recognized, guidelines-based organization focused on emergency
- 17 cardiovascular care [association].
- SECTION 2. Section 38.017(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 19 read as follows:
- 20 (a) Each school district shall make available at each campus
- 21 in the district the number of [at least one] automated external
- 22 defibrillators [defibrillator], as defined by Section 779.001,
- 23 Health and Safety Code, necessary for a defibrillator to be
- 24 accessible from any location on campus so that a person may provide

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- 1 emergency care to a person in cardiac arrest within three minutes of being notified of a possible medical emergency involving cardiac 2 A campus defibrillator must be readily available during 3 any University Interscholastic League athletic competition held on 4 5 the campus. In determining the placement of [location at which to store] a campus defibrillator, the principal of the campus shall 6 consider the guidelines from the American Heart Association or 7 another organization with expertise in emergency cardiovascular 8 care and ensure that the defibrillator is clearly marked [primary 9 10 location on campus where students engage in athletic activities]. SECTION 3. Section 38.018, Education Code, is amended to 11 read as follows: 12 Sec. 38.018. [PROCEDURES REGARDING RESPONSE TO] CARDIAC 13 14 EMERGENCY RESPONSE PLAN [ARREST]. (a) Each school district and 15 private school shall develop and implement a cardiac emergency response plan that establishes safety procedures for a district or 16 17 school employee or other appropriate personnel [student] to follow in responding to a medical emergency involving cardiac arrest on 18 19 district or school grounds[, including the appropriate response time in administering cardiopulmonary resuscitation, using an 20 automated external defibrillator, as defined by Section 779.001, 21 22 Health and Safety Code, or calling a local emergency medical 23 services provider]. In developing the plan, the district or school shall: 24 (1) work directly with local emergency services 25
 - (2) incorporate evidence-based practices, such as the

providers to integrate the plan with the providers' protocols; and

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- 1 American Heart Association's core elements for cardiac emergency
- 2 response plans.
- 3 (c) The plan must include at a minimum:
- 4 (1) the establishment of a cardiac emergency response
- 5 team;
- 6 (2) procedures for activating the cardiac emergency
- 7 response team in response to a medical emergency involving cardiac
- 8 arrest;
- 9 (3) the dissemination of the plan throughout each
- 10 district or school campus;
- 11 (4) ongoing training in first aid, cardiopulmonary
- 12 resuscitation, and the use of automated external defibrillators, as
- 13 defined by Section 779.001, Health and Safety Code, using
- 14 evidence-based guidelines, for appropriate district or school
- 15 employees, including school coaches, school nurses, and athletic
- 16 trainers;
- 17 (5) annual practice drills in responding to a medical
- 18 emergency involving cardiac arrest; and
- 19 (6) annual review, evaluation, and, if necessary,
- 20 modification of the plan.
- 21 <u>(d)</u> A private school is required to develop <u>a cardiac</u>
- 22 emergency response plan [safety procedures] under this section only
- 23 if the school receives an automated external defibrillator from the
- 24 agency or receives funding from the agency to purchase or lease an
- 25 automated external defibrillator.
- 26 (e) The commissioner shall establish a grant program to
- 27 <u>award grants to districts and schools to assist with the</u>

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- 1 implementation of a cardiac emergency response plan. In awarding
- 2 grants, the commissioner shall prioritize districts or schools at
- 3 which at least 50 percent of enrolled students are educationally
- 4 disadvantaged.
- 5 SECTION 4. Not later than the first instructional day of the
- 6 2027-2028 school year, each public school and private school to
- 7 which Sections 38.017 and 38.018, Education Code, as amended by
- 8 this Act, apply shall make available the number of automatic
- 9 external defibrillators and implement a cardiac emergency response
- 10 plan as required by those sections.
- 11 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
