Subchapter E, Chapter 552, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 552.154 to read as follows: 16 Sec. 552.154. STATE HOSPITAL SUPERINTENDENT. The executive 17 commissioner by rule shall require each state hospital to employ a 18 19 superintendent. 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
