- 14 subchapter has, at all times after the designation, an insurable
- 15 interest in the life of the individual who is insured under the
- 16 policy.
- 17 (c) Notwithstanding Section 1103.051, this subsection
- 18 applies to a life insurance policy issued under Chapter 1101. A
- 19 person providing care to an individual with a disability, including
- 20 an intellectual disability, at a state supported living center, as
- 21 defined by Section 531.002, Health and Safety Code, an assisted
- 22 <u>living facility licensed under Chapter 247</u>, Health and Safety Code,
- 23 <u>an intermediate care facility licensed under Chapter 252, Health</u>
- 24 and Safety Code, or a group home, as defined by Section 591.003,

- 1 Health and Safety Code, does not directly or indirectly have an
- 2 insurable interest in the life of an individual unless the person is
- 3 a relative of the individual.
- 4 (d) In this section, "relative" means an individual who is
- 5 related to the insured within the third degree by consanguinity or
- 6 affinity as determined under Chapter 573, Government Code.
- 7 SECTION 2. Section 1103.053(c), Insurance Code, as added by
- 8 this Act, applies only to an insurance policy delivered, issued for
- 9 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
