## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to health benefit plan coverage of telemedicine,
3	teledentistry, and telehealth appointments with an originating
4	site or distant site located outside this state.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 1455.001, Insurance Code, is amended by
7	amending Subdivision (1-a) and adding Subdivisions (1-b) and (1-c)
8	to read as follows:
9	(1-a) "Distant site" means the location where a health
10	professional provides a telemedicine medical service,
11	teledentistry dental service, or telehealth service.
12	(1-b) "Health professional" means:
13	(A) a physician;
14	(B) an individual who is:
15	(i) licensed or certified in this state to
16	perform health care services; and
17	(ii) authorized to assist:
18	(a) a physician in providing
19	telemedicine medical services that are delegated and supervised by
20	the physician; or
21	(b) a dentist in providing
22	teledentistry dental services that are delegated and supervised by
23	the dentist;
24	(C) a licensed or certified health professional

- 1 acting within the scope of the license or certification who does not
- 2 perform a telemedicine medical service or a teledentistry dental
- 3 service; or
- 4 (D) a dentist.
- 5 (1-c) "Originating site" means the location where an
- 6 <u>individual receives a telemedicine medical service, teledentistry</u>
- 7 <u>dental service</u>, or telehealth service.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section 1455.004, Insurance Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 10 (e) A health benefit plan must provide coverage for a
- 11 covered health care service or procedure delivered as a
- 12 telemedicine medical service, teledentistry dental service, or
- 13 telehealth service with an originating site or distant site located
- 14 outside this state on the same basis and to the same extent that the
- 15 plan provides coverage for the service or procedure delivered as a
- 16 telemedicine medical service, teledentistry dental service, or
- 17 telehealth service with an originating site and distant site
- 18 located in this state if:
- 19 (1) the individual who receives the service resides
- 20 primarily in this state; and
- 21 (2) the health professional who provides the service:
- 22 (A) is licensed or otherwise authorized to
- 23 provide the service in this state; and
- 24 <u>(B)</u> has a physical office in this state.
- 25 SECTION 3. Section 1455.004, Insurance Code, as amended by
- 26 this Act, applies only to a health benefit plan delivered, issued
- 27 for delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026. A health

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- 1 benefit plan delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before
- 2 January 1, 2026, is governed by the law as it existed immediately
- 3 before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in
- 4 effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
