A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to creation of the gulf coast protection account to be
- 3 administered by the General Land Office.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 31.070 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 31.070. GULF COAST PROTECTION ACCOUNT. (a) The gulf
- 8 coast protection account is a dedicated account in the general
- 9 revenue fund administered by the land office under this section and
- 10 rules adopted by the land office.
- 11 (b) The gulf coast protection account consists of:
- 12 (1) money from gifts, donations, and grants; and
- (2) money appropriated, credited, or transferred to
- 14 the account by the legislature.
- (c) Money in the gulf coast protection account may be used
- 16 only to pay for expenditures that:
- 17 (1) are necessary to fulfill nonfederal sponsor
- 18 obligations under agreements with the United States Army Corps of
- 19 Engineers for implementing projects included in the plan
- 20 recommended by the Coastal Texas Protection and Restoration
- 21 Feasibility Study Final Report and Final Environmental Impact
- 22 Statement dated August 2021 issued by the Galveston District,
- 23 Southwestern Division, of the United States Army Corps of Engineers
- 24 and the land office;

- 1 (2) comply with the terms of a local cooperation
- 2 agreement executed by the land office and the Gulf Coast Protection
- 3 District established under Chapter 9502, Special District Local
- 4 Laws Code; and
- 5 (3) are for projects that:
- 6 (A) are necessary or useful for the protection of
- 7 the portion of the gulf coast located within the territory of the
- 8 district; or
- 9 (B) would benefit the district and are designated
- 10 <u>as Coastal Storm Risk Management Projects within the Coastal Texas</u>
- 11 Study.
- 12 (d) The legislature finds that the expenditure of money in
- 13 the gulf coast protection account in accordance with Subsection (c)
- 14 serves a public purpose.
- 15 (e) The expenditure of money in the gulf coast protection
- 16 account is subject to audit by the state auditor.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
