## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

intellectual and developmental disability authority to the parents

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to the provision of information regarding a local
- 4 or quardians of certain special education students.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. This Act may be referred to as the Caytlin 7 Handley Act.
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 29.030 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 29.030. PROVISION OF INFORMATION REGARDING LOCAL
- 11 INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AUTHORITY. (a) At the
- 12 first individualized education program committee meeting during
- 13 which a student's individualized education program is developed
- 14 under Section 29.005, a school district shall provide the parent or
- 15 legal guardian of a student who has an intellectual disability or a
- 16 developmental delay with information about services and public
- 17 benefits provided by the local intellectual and developmental
- 18 disability authority that serves the county in which the student
- 19 resides, including services under waiver programs established
- 20 under Section 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section
- 21 1396n(c)).

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- 22 (b) The agency, in collaboration with the Health and Human
- 23 Services Commission, shall develop informational materials that
- 24 include the information described by Subsection (a) and make those

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- 1 materials available for use by school districts.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
- 3 school year.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
