- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 29.030 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 29.030. PROVISION OF INFORMATION REGARDING LOCAL
- 9 INTELLECTUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY AUTHORITY. At the first
- 10 individualized education program committee meeting during which a
- 11 student's individualized education program is developed under
- 12 <u>Section 29.005</u>, a school district shall provide the parent or legal
- 13 guardian of a student who has an intellectual disability or a
- 14 developmental delay with information about services and public
- 15 benefits provided by the local intellectual and developmental
- 16 disability authority, including services under waiver programs
- 17 established under Section 1915(c), Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
- 18 <u>Section 1396n(c)).</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
