Section 37.006, Water Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsections (f) and (g) and adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: 8 9 (f) A person whose license or registration has been expired for not more than 90 [30] days [or less] may apply for renewal of the 10 11 license or registration by paying to the commission a renewal fee in 12 an amount prescribed by commission rule not to exceed 1-1/2 times the normally required renewal fee. Notwithstanding Subsection (e), 13 14 a person who has applied for renewal of the license or registration under this subsection may engage in activities that require a 15 16 license or registration after the expiration of the license or

17 registration until the license or registration is renewed or 18 denied.

(g) <u>A person whose license or registration has been expired</u>
for at least 90 days but not more than 180 days may apply for renewal
of the license or registration by paying to the commission a renewal
fee in an amount prescribed by commission rule not to exceed two
times the normally required renewal fee.
(h) A person whose license or registration has been expired

1 for <u>at least 180 days</u> [more than 30 days] may not renew the license 2 or registration. The person may obtain a new license or 3 registration by complying with the requirements and procedures, 4 including the examination requirements, for obtaining an original 5 license or registration.

6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
