- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 525, Government Code, as
- 7 effective April 1, 2025, is amended by adding Section 525.0304 to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 525.0304. ANNUAL REPORT ON COSTS OF PROVIDING HEALTH
- 10 CARE SERVICES TO FOREIGN PATIENTS. (a) In this section:
- 11 (1) "Emergency care" has the meaning assigned by
- 12 Section 1301.155, Insurance Code.
- 13 (2) "Political subdivision" includes a municipality,
- 14 county, and hospital district in this state.
- 15 (b) The commission shall quarterly collect information on
- 16 the costs incurred by this state and political subdivisions for
- 17 providing at public hospitals inpatient health care services and
- 18 emergency care to uninsured patients who are not citizens or lawful
- 19 permanent residents of the United States.
- 20 <u>(c) A public hospital providing inpatient health care</u>
- 21 services or emergency care to a patient described by Subsection (b)
- 22 shall inform the patient that:
- 23 (1) the hospital must provide to the commission the
- 24 information described by Subsection (b); and

- 1 (2) the provision of the information does not affect
- 2 or limit the hospital's duty to provide the patient care under
- 3 federal law.
- 4 (d) Not later than January 1 of each year, the commission
- 5 shall submit to the governor and the legislature a written report
- 6 outlining the costs incurred by this state and political
- 7 subdivisions for providing inpatient health care services and
- 8 emergency care to patients described by Subsection (b), including
- 9 any recommendations regarding options available for this state to
- 10 seek reimbursement for those costs from the federal government.
- 11 (e) The executive commissioner shall adopt any rules
- 12 necessary to implement this section.
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than October 1, 2025, the
- 14 executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission
- 15 shall adopt any necessary rules as required by Section 525.0304,
- 16 Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 17 (b) The Health and Human Services Commission shall:
- 18 (1) begin collecting the information required by
- 19 Section 525.0304, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later
- 20 than November 1, 2025; and
- 21 (2) submit the first report required by Section
- 22 525.0304, Government Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 23 January 1, 2027.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
