## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to certain federal law enforcement agents serving as armed
3	security officers at public schools and the authority of the chief
4	of school safety and security for the Texas Education Agency to
5	carry a weapon on public school grounds.
6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Section 37.0814(b), Education Code, is amended
8	to read as follows:
9	(b) A security officer described by Subsection (a) must be:
10	(1) a school district peace officer;
11	(2) a school resource officer; [ <del>or</del> ]
12	(3) a commissioned peace officer employed as security
13	personnel under Section 37.081; or
14	(4) a current or former licensed federal law
15	enforcement agent who is authorized to carry a weapon while on duty.
16	SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
17	amended by adding Section 37.088 to read as follows:
18	Sec. 37.088. CHIEF OF SCHOOL SAFETY AND SECURITY. An
19	individual appointed by the governor as chief of school safety and
20	security for the agency may carry a weapon on the grounds of any
21	school district or open-enrollment charter school campus or
22	facility in this state if the individual is a commissioned peace
23	officer or a current or former licensed federal law enforcement
24	agent who is authorized to carry a weapon while on duty.

- 1 SECTION 3. Section 46.15, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 2 Subsection (s) to read as follows:
- 3 (s) Section 46.03(a)(1) does not apply to a person appointed
- 4 as chief of school safety and security for the Texas Education
- 5 Agency if the person is:
- 6 (1) carrying the weapon on the premises of a public
- 7 primary or secondary school or on any grounds or building owned by
- 8 and under the control of the school; and
- 9 (2) authorized to carry a weapon under Section 37.088,
- 10 Education Code.
- 11 SECTION 4. Section 46.15, Penal Code, as amended by this
- 12 Act, applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective
- 13 date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of
- 14 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was
- 15 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed
- 17 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 18 occurred before that date.
- 19 SECTION 5. Section 37.0814, Education Code, as amended by
- 20 this Act, applies beginning with the 2025-2026 school year.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
