- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 2B, Code of Criminal
- 7 Procedure, is amended by adding Article 2B.0254 to read as follows:
- 8 Art. 2B.0254. LAW ENFORCEMENT POLICY ON DISCHARGE OF
- 9 FIREARM AT MOVING VEHICLE. (a) In this article, "law enforcement
- 10 agency" means an agency of the state or an agency of a political
- 11 subdivision of the state authorized by law to employ peace
- 12 <u>officers.</u>
- 13 (b) Each law enforcement agency shall adopt a policy
- 14 regarding a peace officer discharging a firearm at or in the
- 15 direction of a moving vehicle.
- 16 (c) A policy adopted under this article must prohibit a
- 17 peace officer from discharging a firearm at or in the direction of a
- 18 moving vehicle unless the peace officer discharges the firearm only
- 19 when and to the degree the officer reasonably believes is
- 20 immediately necessary to protect the officer or another person from
- 21 the use of unlawful deadly force by an occupant of the vehicle by
- 22 means other than by using the moving vehicle to strike any person.
- 23 SECTION 2. Each law enforcement agency in this state shall
- 24 adopt the policy required by Article 2B.0254, Code of Criminal
