- 3 creating a criminal offense.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Title 9, Agriculture Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Chapter 303 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 303. WEATHER MODIFICATION AND CONTROL PROHIBITED
- 8 Sec. 303.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "weather
- 9 modification and control" means the injection, release, or
- 10 dispersion, by any means, of a chemical, chemical compound,
- 11 substance, or apparatus for the purpose of affecting temperature,
- 12 weather, or the intensity of sunlight.
- 13 Sec. 303.002. PROHIBITION ON WEATHER MODIFICATION AND
- 14 CONTROL. A person may not engage in weather modification and
- 15 control.

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- Sec. 303.003. ENFORCEMENT. (a) A person commits an offense
- 17 if the person violates this chapter.
- 18 (b) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor.
- (c) A person commits a separate offense for each day the
- 20 <u>violation occurs.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Chapters 301 and 302, Agriculture Code, are
- 22 repealed.
- SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 24 an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An

- 1 offense committed before the effective date of this Act is governed
- 2 by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 4 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 5 this Act if any element of the offense occurred before that date.
- 6 SECTION 4. (a) An action, including a disciplinary or
- 7 administrative proceeding, pending under Chapter 301, Agriculture
- 8 Code, or Chapter 51, Occupations Code, on the effective date of this
- 9 Act related to a violation of Chapter 301, Agriculture Code, as that
- 10 chapter existed immediately before the effective date of this Act,
- 11 is dismissed.
- 12 (b) An administrative penalty assessed by the Texas
- 13 Commission of Licensing and Regulation before the effective date of
- 14 this Act related to a violation of Chapter 301, Agriculture Code, as
- 15 that chapter existed immediately before the effective date of this
- 16 Act, may be collected as provided by Chapter 51, Occupations Code.
- 17 (c) The Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall
- 18 return to a person who holds a valid license or permit issued under
- 19 Chapter 301, Agriculture Code, as that chapter existed immediately
- 20 before the effective date of this Act, a prorated portion of the fee
- 21 paid to the department for the issuance or renewal of the license or
- 22 permit.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
