12	(A) a Saturday, Sunday, or legal state or

14	(B) in the case of a payment of taxes imposed by a
15	taxing unit, a day on which the office of the collector for the
16	taxing unit is closed; and
17	(2) [ $_{ au}$ ] the act is [timely if] performed on the next
18	regular business day.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
