3 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the 4 application of this section, including rules that:

5 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this 6 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a 7 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those 8 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and

9 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be 10 considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this 11 section.

SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 48, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 48.2521 to read as follows:

14 Sec. 48.2521. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR SALARY INCREASES FOR 15 CERTAIN PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES. A school district, including a school district that is otherwise ineligible for state aid under 16 17 this chapter, is entitled to state aid in an amount equal to the product of \$4,000 multiplied by the number of classroom teachers, 18 full-time librarians, full-time school counselors certified under 19 Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time school nurses employed by 20 the district. 21

 repealed.
 SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026
