Section 431.002, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Subdivision (5-a) to read as follows: 6 (5-a) "Cell-cultured protein" means a food product 7 derived from harvesting animal cells and artificially replicating 8 9 those cells in a growth medium to produce tissue. SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 431, Health and Safety 10 11 Code, is amended by adding Section 431.02105 to read as follows: 12 Sec. 431.02105. PROHIBITED ACT; TEMPORARY PROVISION. (a) The offering for sale or sale of cell-cultured protein for human 13 14 consumption within this state is unlawful and prohibited. (b) A violation of this section may be enforced in the same 15 manner as a violation of Section 431.021 is enforced under 16 <u>Subchapter</u> C. 17 (c) This section expires September 1, 2027. 18 SECTION 3. Sections 431.0805(4), (5), (6), (7), (8), (9), 19 and (10), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: 20 21 (4) "Egg" has the meaning assigned by Section 4(g), Egg Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 1033(g)). The term 22 23 does not include an analogue product or $[\frac{1}{4}]$ cell-cultured protein [product]. 24

the federal Act (21 U.S.C. Section 343(q)(4)(E)). The term does not
include an analogue product or [a] cell-cultured protein [product].
(7) "Meat" has the meaning assigned by 9 C.F.R.
9 Section 301.2. The term does not include an analogue product or [a]
cell-cultured protein [product].

(8) "Meat food product" has the meaning assigned by Section 1(j), Federal Meat Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 601(j)). The term does not include an analogue product or [a] cell-cultured <u>protein</u> [product].

(9) "Poultry" has the meaning assigned by Section
4(e), Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section 453(e)).
The term does not include an analogue product or [a] cell-cultured
protein [product].

(10) "Poultry product" has the meaning assigned by
Section 4(f), Poultry Products Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. Section
453(f)). The term does not include an analogue product or [a]
cell-cultured protein [product].

LABELING CELL-CULTURED PROTEIN [PRODUCT]. 5 (a) In this section: 6 (1) "Cell-cultured protein [product]" has the meaning assigned by Section <u>431.002</u> [431.0805]. 7 "Close proximity" means: 8 (2) 9 immediately before or after the name of the (A) 10 product; (B) in the line of the label immediately before 11 12 or after the line containing the name of the product; or (C) within the same phrase or sentence containing 13 14 the name of the product. 15 (b) <u>Cell-cultured protein</u> [A cell-cultured product] must be labeled in prominent type equal to or greater in size than the 16 17 surrounding type and in close proximity to the name of the protein [product] using one of the following: 18 "cell-cultured"; 19 (1) (2) "lab-grown"; or 20 a similar qualifying term or disclaimer intended 21 (3) to clearly communicate to a consumer the contents of the protein 22 23 [product]. 24 (c) The provisions of this subchapter apply to [a] cell-cultured protein [product], as applicable. 25 26 SECTION 6. Subchapter D, Chapter 433, Health and Safety Code, is amended by adding Section 433.057 to read as follows: 27

(a) In this section, "cell-cultured protein" 2 has the meaning assigned by Section 431.002. 3 4 (b) A person may not offer for sale or sell cell-cultured 5 protein for human consumption. 6 (c) To the extent another state law conflicts with this 7 section, this section controls. 8 (d) This section expires September 1, 2027. SECTION 7. Section 431.0805(2), Health and Safety Code, is 9 repealed. 10 SECTION 8. As soon as practicable after the effective date 11 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human 12 Services Commission shall adopt any rules necessary to implement 13 the changes in law made by this Act. 14 15 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
