## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the Internet broadcast or recording of certain open
3 meetings.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 551, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Sections 551.024 and 551.025 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 551.024. INTERNET BROADCAST AND ARCHIVE OF OPEN
- 8 MEETINGS. (a) This section applies only to a governmental body
- 9 that is an agency within the executive branch of state government:
- 10 (1) to which the total appropriation made in the
- 11 General Appropriations Act from general revenue as specified in the
- 12 method of financing for any fiscal year beginning on or after
- 13 September 1, 2025, including any amount of general revenue
- 14 transferred to the governmental body under that Act for that fiscal
- 15 year, is greater than \$10 million; and
- 16 (2) for which the bill pattern for the General
- 17 Appropriations Act for the same fiscal year designates 100 or more
- 18 <u>full-time equivalent positions.</u>
- 19 (b) A governmental body that becomes subject to this section
- 20 under Subsection (a) for a fiscal year shall comply with this
- 21 section in each following fiscal year.
- 22 <u>(c) A governmental body subject to this section shall</u>
- 23 broadcast over the Internet live video and audio of each open
- 24 meeting of the governmental body. The governmental body shall

- 1 provide access to the broadcast on the governmental body's Internet
- 2 website.
- 3 (d) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open
- 4 meeting is broadcast under this section, the governmental body
- 5 shall make available through the governmental body's Internet
- 6 website archived video and audio of the open meeting. The
- 7 governmental body shall maintain the archived video and audio of
- 8 the open meeting on the governmental body's Internet website until
- 9 the second anniversary of the date the archived video and audio was
- 10 first made available on the website.
- 11 (e) The governmental body shall provide on the governmental
- 12 body's Internet website the same notice of the open meeting that the
- 13 governmental body is required to post under Subchapter C. The
- 14 <u>notice must be posted on the governmental body's Internet website</u>
- 15 within the time required for posting notice under Subchapter C.
- (f) The governmental body may use for an Internet broadcast
- of an open meeting of the governmental body a room made available to
- 18 the governmental body on request in any state building, as defined
- 19 by Section 2165.301.
- 20 (g) The governmental body is exempt from the requirements of
- 21 this section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section
- 22 <u>551.0411</u>, or a technical breakdown prevents the governmental body
- 23 from complying with this section. Following the catastrophe or
- 24 technical breakdown, the governmental body shall make all
- 25 reasonable efforts to make the required video and audio of the open
- 26 meeting available in a timely manner.
- 27 (h) The governmental body shall consider contracting

- 1 through competitive bidding with a private individual or entity to
- 2 broadcast and archive an open meeting subject to this section to
- 3 minimize the cost of complying with this section.
- 4 Sec. 551.025. INTERNET ACCESS TO RECORDING OF OPEN MEETING.
- 5 (a) This section applies only to a governmental body that is an
- 6 agency within:
- 7 (1) the legislative branch of the state government; or
- 8 (2) the executive branch of the state government to
- 9 which Section 551.024 does not apply.
- 10 (b) Not later than the seventh day after the date an open
- 11 meeting is held, a governmental body subject to this section shall
- 12 make available through the governmental body's Internet website or
- 13 a social media account associated with the governmental body:
- 14 (1) an audio recording of the open meeting; or
- 15 (2) a video and audio recording of the open meeting.
- 16 (c) The governmental body shall provide on the governmental
- 17 body's Internet website or a social media account associated with
- 18 the governmental body the same notice of the open meeting that the
- 19 governmental body is required to post under Subchapter C. The
- 20 notice must be posted on the governmental body's Internet website
- 21 or a social media account associated with the governmental body
- 22 within the time required for posting notice under Subchapter C.
- 23 (d) The governmental body is exempt from the requirements of
- 24 this section to the extent a catastrophe, as defined by Section
- 25 551.0411, or a technical breakdown prevents the governmental body
- 26 from complying with this section. Following the catastrophe or
- 27 technical breakdown, the governmental body shall make all

- 1 reasonable efforts to make the required recording of the open
- 2 meeting available in a timely manner.
- 3 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), this section does not
- 4 apply to a commodity producers board created under Chapter 41,
- 5 Agriculture Code. This subsection expires September 1, 2030.
- 6 SECTION 2. Sections 551.024 and 551.025, Government Code,
- 7 as added by this Act, apply only to an open meeting held on or after
- 8 September 1, 2027.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
