- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 224.002(c), Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The policy <u>shall</u> [may] include procedures for a covered
- 9 individual to be exempt from the required vaccines based on reasons
- 10 of conscience, including a religious belief. A health care
- 11 facility shall not reject an exemption based on reasons of
- 12 conscience, including a religious belief, for any reason.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
