A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of an environmental product declaration

- 3 grant program for certain manufacturers of ready-mixed concrete.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 5, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 5.1245 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5.1245. ENVIRONMENTAL PRODUCT DECLARATION GRANT
- 8 PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN MANUFACTURERS OF READY-MIXED CONCRETE. (a) In
- 9 this section, "environmental product declaration" means an
- 10 <u>independently verified product-specific label that discloses the</u>
- 11 environmental impact of a manufactured product based on a life
- 12 cycle assessment.
- 13 <u>(b) This section applies only to a manufacturer of</u>
- 14 ready-mixed concrete that:
- 15 <u>(1) is a corporation, partnership, sole</u>
- 16 proprietorship, or other legal entity formed for the purpose of
- 17 making a profit;
- 18 (2) is independently owned and operated; and
- 19 (3) has fewer than 100 employees or less than \$6
- 20 million in annual gross receipts.
- 21 (c) The commission shall establish and administer a grant
- 22 program to reimburse manufacturers of ready-mixed concrete
- 23 <u>described</u> by Subsection (b) for the cost of accessing an
- 24 environmental product declaration database or other software for

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- 1 generating environmental product declarations for ready-mixed
- 2 concrete products.
- 3 (d) As a condition of receiving a grant under this section,
- 4 a manufacturer must agree to use environmental product declarations
- 5 for the manufacturer's ready-mixed concrete products.
- 6 (e) The commission shall adopt rules to implement the
- 7 program established under this section, including rules
- 8 establishing:
- 9 (1) eligibility criteria for grant applicants;
- 10 (2) grant application procedures;
- 11 (3) criteria for evaluating grant applications and
- 12 awarding grants;
- 13 (4) guidelines related to grant amounts; and
- 14 (5) procedures for monitoring the use of a grant
- 15 awarded under this section and ensuring compliance with any
- 16 conditions of the grant.
- 17 SECTION 2. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality
- 18 shall adopt rules and establish procedures under Section 5.1245,
- 19 Water Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after the
- 20 effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
