A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 411.201(a)(3), Government Code, is 1-25 amended to read as follows: (3)

1-26 "Retired judicial officer" means: 1-27 1-28 a visiting judge appointed under Section (A) 26.023 or 26.024;

1-29 (B) a senior judge designated under Section 75.001 or a judicial officer as designated or defined by Section 1-30 75.001, 831.001, or 836.001; [or] 1-31

1-32 (C) a retired federal judge who is a resident of 1-33 this state; or

1-34 a retired judge of a constitutional county (D) 1-35 court or statutory county court who served at least 48 months in a 1-36

<u>constitutional county court or statutory county court</u>. <u>SECTION 2.</u> The change in law made by this Act applies only to an application for a license to carry a handgun submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in 1-37 1-38 1-39 1-40 effect on the date the application was submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 1-41 1-42

1-43 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
