H.B. No. 1512

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to reporting the number of children known or reasonably believed to not be citizens of the United States enrolled in a 3 public school and to requesting reimbursement from the United 4 5 States government for the cost of educating those children. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 25.001, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsections (k), (l), and (m) to read as follows: 8 9 (k) A school district shall include in the district's Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) report, in the 10 11 manner and form prescribed by commissioner rule, the number of 12 persons admitted to the district under this section whom the district knows or reasonably believes to not be citizens of the 13 14 United States. Nothing in this subsection authorizes a school district to deny admission to any person who is eligible under 15 16 Subsection (b). (1) The commissioner shall annually submit to the United 17 States government a request that the United States government 18 reimburse the state for the cost of educating the total number of 19 persons reported under <u>Subsection (k)</u> by all school districts. 20 21 (m) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to 22 implement Subsections (k) and (l), including rules to ensure that 23 information reported under those subsections does not contain personally identifiable information of a student. 24

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H.B. No. 1512 1 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2025-2026 2 school year.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
