Tuition and other fees charged for an academic period before that semester are governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
