1 suit affecting the parent-child relationship that is filed on or 2 after the effective date of this Act. A suit filed before the 3 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the 4 date that the suit is filed, and the former law is continued in 5 effect for that purpose.

## 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
