- 2 relating to the sunset review process and certain governmental
- 3 entities subject to that process.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 ARTICLE 1. ENTITIES GIVEN 2031 SUNSET DATE
- 6 SECTION 1.01. CREDIT UNION DEPARTMENT. Section 15.212,
- 7 Finance Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 15.212. SUNSET PROVISION. The Credit Union Department
- 9 and the Credit Union Commission are subject to Chapter 325,
- 10 Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence
- 11 as provided by that chapter, the department and commission are
- 12 abolished September 1, 2031 [2035].
- 13 SECTION 1.02. STATE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS.
- 14 Section 2003.023, Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 2003.023. SUNSET PROVISION. The State Office of
- 16 Administrative Hearings is subject to review under Chapter 325
- 17 (Texas Sunset Act), but is not abolished under that chapter. The
- 18 office shall be reviewed during the periods in which state agencies
- 19 abolished in 2031 [2027] and every 12th year after 2031 [2027] are
- 20 reviewed.
- 21 SECTION 1.03. TEXAS JUVENILE JUSTICE DEPARTMENT. (a)
- 22 Section 202.010, Human Resources Code, is amended to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 202.010. SUNSET PROVISION. The Texas Juvenile Justice

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- 1 Board and the Texas Juvenile Justice Department are subject to
- 2 Chapter 325, Government Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued
- 3 in existence as provided by that chapter, the board and the
- 4 department are abolished September 1, 2031 [2027].
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding Section 202.010, Human Resources Code,
- 6 as amended by this Act, the Sunset Advisory Commission shall
- 7 conduct a limited-scope review of the Texas Juvenile Justice
- 8 Department for the 90th Legislature.
- 9 (c) In conducting the limited-scope review under this
- 10 section, the Sunset Advisory Commission staff evaluation and report
- 11 must be limited to assessing the Texas Juvenile Justice
- 12 Department's administration of its regionalization duties aimed at
- 13 prioritizing the use of local levels of the juvenile justice system
- 14 over placement or commitment to secure facilities operated by the
- 15 Texas Juvenile Justice Department.
- 16 (d) The Sunset Advisory Commission may not review the office
- 17 of independent ombudsman of the Texas Juvenile Justice Department
- 18 as part of the limited-scope review conducted under this section.
- 19 (e) The Sunset Advisory Commission's recommendations to the
- 20 90th Legislature may include any recommendation the commission
- 21 considers appropriate based on the limited-scope review conducted
- 22 under this section.
- 23 (f) The Texas Juvenile Justice Department shall submit a
- 24 report not later than September 1, 2026, to the Sunset Advisory
- 25 Commission, the speaker of the house of representatives, the
- 26 lieutenant governor, and the standing committees of each house of
- 27 the legislature with primary jurisdiction over juvenile justice

- 1 that includes information about:
- 2 (1) the status of the United States Department of
- 3 Justice's investigation into the Texas Juvenile Justice Department
- 4 and the Texas Juvenile Justice Department's progress in addressing
- 5 findings as detailed in the United States Department of Justice's
- 6 report titled "Investigation of the Texas Juvenile Justice
- 7 Department," published on August 1, 2024;
- 8 (2) the waitlist of youth committed to the Texas
- 9 Juvenile Justice Department awaiting transfer to state secure
- 10 facilities from county facilities;
- 11 (3) the Texas Juvenile Justice Department's staffing
- 12 and turnover at state facilities for each fiscal year since fiscal
- 13 year 2016; and
- 14 (4) the progress on construction of additional state
- 15 juvenile correctional facilities for which the legislature
- 16 appropriated funding in the 2024-2025 biennium.
- 17 ARTICLE 2. ENTITIES GIVEN 2033 SUNSET DATE
- 18 SECTION 2.01. STATE BOARD OF VETERINARY MEDICAL EXAMINERS.
- 19 Section 801.003, Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 801.003. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The State Board of
- 21 Veterinary Medical Examiners is subject to Chapter 325, Government
- 22 Code (Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided
- 23 by that chapter, the board is abolished September 1, 2033 [2027].
- 24 ARTICLE 3. ENTITIES GIVEN 2035 SUNSET DATE
- 25 SECTION 3.01. STATE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION BOARD.
- 26 Section 12, Chapter 358 (S.B. 1424), Acts of the 88th Legislature,
- 27 Regular Session, 2023, is repealed.

- 1 ARTICLE 4. AMENDMENTS TO THE TEXAS SUNSET ACT
- 2 SECTION 4.01. SUNSET ADVISORY COMMISSION. Section
- 3 325.003(a-1), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 (a-1) A public member acts on behalf of the legislature when
- 5 participating on the commission in furtherance of the legislature's
- 6 duty to provide oversight of state [executive branch] agencies'
- 7 implementation of legislative priorities.
- 8 SECTION 4.02. AGENCY REPORT TO COMMISSION. Section
- 9 325.007(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) Before September 1 of the odd-numbered year before the
- 11 year in which a state agency subject to this chapter is abolished or
- 12 reviewed, the agency shall report to the commission:
- 13 (1) information regarding the application to the
- 14 agency of the criteria in Section 325.011; and
- 15 (2) any other information that the agency considers
- 16 appropriate or that is requested by the commission.
- 17 SECTION 4.03. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF AGENCY BEING
- 18 REVIEWED. Section 325.0075, Government Code, is amended to read as
- 19 follows:
- Sec. 325.0075. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF AGENCY BEING
- 21 REVIEWED. Before September 1 of the odd-numbered year before the
- 22 year in which a state agency subject to this chapter is abolished or
- 23 <u>reviewed</u>, the agency shall submit to the commission, the governor,
- 24 the lieutenant governor, and each member of the legislature a
- 25 report that:
- 26 (1) lists each report that the agency is required by a
- 27 statute to prepare; and

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- 1 (2) evaluates the need for each report listed in
- 2 Subdivision (1) based on whether factors or conditions have changed
- 3 since the date the statutory requirement to prepare the report was
- 4 enacted.
- 5 SECTION 4.04. COMMISSION DUTIES. Section 325.008(a),
- 6 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Before January 1 of the year in which a state agency
- 8 subject to this chapter and its advisory committees are abolished
- 9 or reviewed, the commission shall:
- 10 (1) review and take action necessary to verify the
- 11 reports submitted by the agency under Section 325.007;
- 12 (2) consult the Legislative Budget Board, the
- 13 Governor's Budget, Policy, and Planning Division, the State
- 14 Auditor, and the comptroller of public accounts, or their
- 15 successors, on the application to the agency of the criteria
- 16 provided in Section 325.011;
- 17 (3) conduct a review of the agency based on the
- 18 criteria provided in Section 325.011 and prepare a written report;
- 19 and
- 20 (4) review the implementation of commission
- 21 recommendations contained in the reports presented to the
- 22 legislature during the preceding legislative session and the
- 23 resulting legislation.
- SECTION 4.05. PUBLIC HEARINGS. Section 325.009(a),
- 25 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 26 (a) Before February 1 of the year a state agency subject to
- 27 this chapter and its advisory committees are abolished or reviewed,

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- 1 the commission shall conduct public hearings concerning but not
- 2 limited to the application to the agency of the criteria provided in
- 3 Section 325.011.
- 4 SECTION 4.06. REVIEW OF CERTAIN AGENCIES. Sections
- 5 325.0125(a) and (b), Government Code, are amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) In the two-year period preceding the date scheduled for
- 8 the abolition or review of a state agency under this chapter, the
- 9 commission may exempt certain agencies from the requirements of
- 10 this chapter relating to staff reports, hearings, and reviews.
- 11 (b) The commission may only exempt agencies that have been
- 12 inactive for a period of two years preceding the date the agency is
- 13 scheduled for abolition or review, that have been rendered inactive
- 14 by an action of the legislature, or that the commission determines
- 15 are unable to participate in the review due to a declared disaster.
- 16 ARTICLE 5. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 17 SECTION 5.01. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 18 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 19 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 20 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 21 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
