6	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 88, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 88.823 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 88.823. PEST, DISEASE, AND QUARANTINE ALERT SYSTEM.
9	(a) With the cooperation of the Department of Agriculture, the
10	Texas Animal Health Commission, and the Parks and Wildlife
11	Department, the extension service shall develop and implement a
12	statewide Internet-based alert system for notifications related to
13	wildlife and plant pests, diseases, and quarantines. The alert
14	system must issue notifications for:
15	(1) a confirmed case of a dangerous plant or wildlife
16	pest or disease;
17	(2) the establishment, modification, or removal of a
18	pest or disease quarantine order; and
19	(3) any compliance agreements entered into with the
20	Department of Agriculture related to a pest or disease quarantine.
21	(b) The alert system established under this section must:
22	(1) issue notifications through e-mail; and
23	(2) provide for enrollment in the alert system for
24	delivery of a system notification.

1	(c) The extension service shall enter into a memorandum of
2	understanding with the Department of Agriculture, the Texas Animal
3	Health Commission, and the Parks and Wildlife Department to ensure
4	the extension service is able to issue a required notification
5	under Subsection (a) within 72 hours of an applicable action by
6	those agencies.
7	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
