The alert 13 system must is <u>sue notifications for</u>: 14 (1) a confirmed case of a dangerous plant or wildlife 15 16 pest or disease; (2) the establishment, modification, or removal of a 17 pest or disease quarantine order; and 18 (3) any compliance agreements entered into with the 19 Department of Agriculture related to a pest or disease quarantine. 20 21 (b) The alert system established under this section must: (1) issue notifications through e-mail; and 22 23 (2) provide for enrollment in the alert system for delivery of a system notification. 24
