## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-19 relating to an alert system for dangerous plant and wildlife pests 1-20 and diseases administered by the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension 1-21 Service. 1-22 1-23

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 88, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 88.823 to read as follows: 1-24

(a) With the cooperation of the Department of Agriculture, the Texas Animal Health Commission, and the Parks and Wildlife Department, the extension service shall develop and implement a 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 statewide Internet-based alert system for notifications related to 1-30 wildlife and plant pests, diseases, and quarantines. The alert system must issue notifications for: (1) a confirmed case of a dangerous plant or wildlife 1-31 1-32 1 - 33pest or disease;

(3) any compliance agreements entered into with the of Agriculture related to a pest or disease quarantine. The alert system established under this section must: 1-36 1-37 Department 1-38 (b)

(2) provide for enrollment in the alert system for 1-40 delivery of a system notification. (c) The extension service 1-41

(c) The extension service shall enter into a memorandum of understanding with the Department of Agriculture, the Texas Animal 1-42 1-43 Health Commission, and the Parks and Wildlife Department to ensure 1 - 441-45 the extension service is able to issue a required notification under Subsection (a) within 72 hours of an applicable action by 1-46 1-47 those agencies. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
