- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks
- 8 permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during
- 9 periods:
- 10 (1) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4;
- 11 (2) beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on
- 12 January 1 of the following year; and
- 13 (3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if
- 14 the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 150 $[\frac{100}{100}]$
- 15 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which
- 16 the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of
- 17 fireworks during the period.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
