1-17 relating to fireworks sales to the public by retail fireworks 1-18 permit holders in certain counties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 2154.202(g), Occupations Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (g) Except as provided by Subsection (h), a retail fireworks permit holder may sell fireworks only to the public, and only during periods:
 - (1) beginning June 24 and ending at midnight on July 4; (2) beginning December 20 and ending at midnight on
- January 1 of the following year; and

 1-28 (3) beginning May 1 and ending at midnight on May 5 if

 1-29 the fireworks are sold at a location that is not more than 150 [100]

 1-30 miles from the Texas-Mexico border and that is in a county in which

 1-31 the commissioners court of the county has approved the sale of

 1-32 fireworks during the period.

1-33 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-34 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-35 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 1-36 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-37 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
