## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to authorizing certain cities to change the date on which

- their general election for officers is held.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 41.0052, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (f) to read as follows:
- 7 (f) The governing body of a city with a population of 9,000
- 8 or less, located predominantly in a county that has a total area of
- 9 less than 6,200 square miles, that has adopted a council-manager
- 10 form of government and that holds its general election for officers
- 11 on a date other than the November uniform election date may, not
- 12 <u>later than December 31, 2026, change the date on which it holds its</u>
- 13 general election for officers to the November uniform election
- 14 date. Subsections (b), (c), and (d) apply to the change of an
- 15 <u>election date under this subsection</u>. This subsection expires
- 16 January 1, 2027.

- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
