4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 659.081, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 659.081. STATE OFFICERS: PAYMENT ONCE A MONTH. Except
8	as provided by [this subchapter or] the General Appropriations Act,
9	annual salaries for state officers [and employees] shall be paid
10	once a month.
11	SECTION 2. Section 659.082, Government Code, is amended to
12	read as follows:
13	Sec. 659.082. STATE EMPLOYEES: PAYMENT TWICE A MONTH.
14	Except as provided by the General Appropriations Act, annual
15	salaries for state employees shall [(a) An employee is entitled to]
16	be paid [employment compensation] twice a month [if:
17	(1) the employee is employed by:
18	[(A) the Texas Department of Mental Health and
19	Mental Retardation;
20	[(B) the Texas Department of Transportation;
21	[(C) the Texas Department of Human Services;
22	[(D) the Texas Workforce Commission;
23	[(E) the Department of Public Safety; or
2.4	(F) any other state agency designated by the

- [(2) the employee holds a classified position under the
- state's position classification plan; 3
- 4 [(3) the employee's position is classified below salary
- 5 group A12 under classification salary Schedule A in the General
- Appropriations Act; 6
- 7 [(4) the employing state agency satisfies the
- 8 comptroller's requirements relating to the payment of compensation
- twice a month; and 9
- 10 [(5) at least 30 percent of the eligible employees of
- the agency choose to be paid twice a month]. 11
- [(b) Employees of an institution of higher education as 12
- defined by Section 61.003, Education Code, may be paid twice a month 13
- at the election of the employing institution of higher education. 14
- 15 SECTION 3. Sections 659.083(a) and (b), Government Code,
- are amended to read as follows: 16
- The [Except as provided by Subsection (b), the] 17
- comptroller may not pay the salary of a state officer [or employee] 18
- before the first working day of the month following the payroll 19
- period. 20
- 21 The comptroller $\underline{\text{may}}$ not $\underline{\text{pay}}$ the salary of a state
- employee before [shall pay an employee who is paid twice a month 22
- under Section 659.082 on]: 23
- 24 the first working day of the month following the
- payroll period that covers the last half of the preceding month; and 25
- (2) the 15th day of the month or the first working day 26
- after the 15th for the payroll period that covers the first half of 27

- 1 the month.
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 659.084, Government Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 659.084. ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER. Salaries for
- 5 state officers and employees [paid once a month] shall be paid
- 6 through electronic funds transfer under Section 403.016 unless paid
- 7 on warrant as permitted under that section.
- 8 SECTION 5. Section 659.085(d), Government Code, is amended
- 9 to read as follows:
- 10 (d) An agency that may contract with its employees for
- 11 employment for less than a 12-month period may make equal [monthly]
- 12 salary payments under the contract during the contract period or
- 13 during the fiscal year in accordance with the General
- 14 Appropriations Act and equitable rules adopted by the comptroller,
- 15 provided that the salary payments are made twice a month to the
- 16 <u>employees</u>.
- SECTION 6. Section 825.405(c), Government Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 (c) Monthly, employers shall:
- 20 (1) report to the retirement system in a form
- 21 prescribed by the system a certification of the total amount of
- 22 salary paid above the statutory minimum salary and the total amount
- 23 of employer contributions due under this section for the [payroll]
- 24 period covered by the report; and
- 25 (2) retain information, as determined by the
- 26 retirement system, sufficient to allow administration of this
- 27 section, including information for each employee showing the

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- 1 applicable minimum salary as well as aggregate annual compensation.
- 2 SECTION 7. Section 825.407(c), Government Code, is amended
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 (c) The designated disbursing officer of each general
- 5 academic teaching institution and the designated disbursing
- 6 officer of each medical and dental unit shall:
- 7 (1) submit to the retirement system, at a time and in
- 8 the manner prescribed by the retirement system, a monthly report
- 9 containing a certification of the total amount of salary paid from
- 10 noneducational and general funds and the total amount of employer
- 11 contributions due under this section for the [payroll] period
- 12 covered by the report; and
- 13 (2) maintain and retain the following information:
- 14 (A) the name of each member employed by the
- 15 institution or unit who, for the [most recent payroll] period
- 16 covered by the report, was paid wholly or partly from
- 17 noneducational and general funds;
- 18 (B) the amount of the employee's salary for the
- 19 [most recent payroll] period covered by the report that was paid
- 20 from noneducational and general funds; and
- (C) any other information the retirement system
- 22 determines is necessary to administer this section.
- SECTION 8. Section 825.4071(c), Government Code, is amended
- 24 to read as follows:
- 25 (c) The designated disbursing officer of each public junior
- 26 college and each public junior college district shall:
- 27 (1) submit to the retirement system, at a time and in

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- 1 the manner prescribed by the retirement system, a monthly report
- 2 containing a certification that includes:
- 3 (A) the total amount of compensation paid;
- 4 (B) the total amount of employer contributions
- 5 due under this section for the [payroll] period covered by the
- 6 report; and
- 7 (C) any other information the retirement system
- 8 determines is necessary to administer this section; and
- 9 (2) maintain and retain the following information:
- 10 (A) the name of each member employed by the
- 11 public junior college or public junior college district;
- 12 (B) the amount of the member's salary for the
- 13 [most recent payroll] period covered by the report;
- 14 (C) whether the member is a qualifying employee
- 15 under Section 825.404(a-1)(1); and
- 16 (D) any other information the retirement system
- 17 determines is necessary to administer this section.
- 18 SECTION 9. A state agency may adopt rules to implement this
- 19 Act.
- 20 SECTION 10. The changes in law made by this Act apply only
- 21 to the payment of compensation to a state employee for services
- 22 provided by the employee on or after September 1, 2025. The payment
- 23 of compensation to a state employee for services provided by the
- 24 employee before September 1, 2025, is governed by the law in effect
- 25 on the date the employee provided the services, and the former law
- 26 is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 11. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
