11	impacts associated with groundwater development, including:
12	(1) maintaining operability of wells significantly
13	affected by groundwater development, including wells located
14	outside the district;
15	(2) developing or distributing alternative water
16	supplies; and
17	(3) conducting aquifer monitoring, data collection,
18	and aquifer science.
19	(c) A district may use funds described by Subsection (b) to
20	maintain the operability of wells described by Subsection (b)(1)
21	that are located in another district only if the district enters
22	into an interlocal contract under Chapter 791, Government Code,
23	with the other district authorizing the funds to be used for that
24	purpose.
