6	SECTION 1. Chapter 546, Government Code, as effective April
7	1, 2025, is amended by adding Subchapter J-1 to read as follows:
8	SUBCHAPTER J-1. COMMUNITY LIVING ASSISTANCE AND SUPPORT SERVICES
9	(CLASS) WAIVER PROGRAM
10	Sec. 546.0472. HABILITATION TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. To
11	the extent permitted by federal law, an individual who provides
12	habilitation transportation services to a recipient under the
13	community living assistance and support services (CLASS) waiver
14	program is entitled to compensation for all time spent operating a
15	motor vehicle in connection with transporting a recipient,
16	including time spent returning a recipient's vehicle to a
17	designated location without the recipient as a passenger.
18	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
19	a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
20	federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
21	the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
22	authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
23	waiver or authorization is granted.
