- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 5002.053, Special
- 6 District Local Laws Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 5002.053. ELECTION BY POSITION; QUALIFICATIONS; TERM
- 8 LIMITS.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 5002.053, Special District Local Laws
- 10 Code, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 11 (c) To be eligible to be elected as a commissioner, a person
- 12 may not have previously served two or more full terms as a
- 13 commissioner. The completion of the remainder of an unexpired term
- 14 by a person elected or appointed to fill a vacancy does not
- 15 constitute service for a full term for purposes of this subsection.
- SECTION 3. Section 5002.053(c), Special District Local Laws
- 17 Code, as added by this Act, does not apply to a term of office that
- 18 began before the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 20 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 21 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 22 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 23 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 24 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,

- 2 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 3 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 4 Environmental Quality.
- 5 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 6 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 7 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 8 representatives within the required time.
- 9 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 10 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 11 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 12 and accomplished.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
