A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study regarding the effects of perfluoroalkyl and
- 3 polyfluoroalkyl chemicals on public health.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. STUDY. The president of the University of
- 6 Houston shall designate a department or entity at the university to
- 7 conduct, in collaboration with the Railroad Commission of Texas and
- 8 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, a study on the
- 9 effects of perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl chemicals on public
- 10 health. The study must include an assessment of the health impact of
- 11 perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl chemicals found in:
- 12 (1) produce, meat, and other food and beverage
- 13 products, including their packaging;
- 14 (2) groundwater, rivers, lakes, reservoirs, and other
- 15 water sources used to supply the public with drinking water; and
- 16 (3) equipment or materials that:
- 17 (A) likely contain perfluoroalkyl and
- 18 polyfluoroalkyl chemicals; and
- 19 (B) regularly come in contact with
- 20 professionals, including firefighters and chemical manufacturing
- 21 workers.
- SECTION 2. REPORT. Not later than December 1, 2026,
- 23 the department or entity at the University of Houston designated
- 24 by the president of the university to conduct the study under

- 1 Section 1 of this Act shall prepare a report with the conclusions of
- 2 the study and submit the report to the legislature.
- 3 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires December 31, 2026.
- 4 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 5 1, 2025.
