- 8 Sec. 455.152. INELIGIBILITY FOR LICENSE. A person is not
- 9 eligible for a license as a massage establishment, massage school,
- 10 massage therapist, or massage therapy instructor if the person is
- 11 an individual and has been convicted of, entered a plea of nolo
- 12 contendere or guilty to, or received deferred adjudication for:
- 13 (1) an offense under Chapter 20A, Penal Code [Section
- 14 22.011 or 22.021 Penal Code], or Section 22.011, 22.012, 22.021,
- 15 43.021, 43.03, 43.031, 43.04, 43.041, or 43.05, Penal Code; or
- 16 (2) an offense under federal law or the laws of another
- 17 state containing elements that are substantially similar to the
- 18 elements of an offense described by Subdivision (1).
- SECTION 2. Section 455.251(b), Occupations Code, is amended
- 20 to read as follows:
- 21 (b) The commission or executive director shall revoke the

- 24 (1) the person is convicted of, enters a plea of nolo
