H.B. No. 1767

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the procedure by which a taxing unit is required to
3 provide public notice of certain ad valorem tax-related
4 information.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 26.04, Tax Code, is amended by adding
7 Subsection (e-7) to read as follows:

8 (e-7) By August 7 or as soon thereafter as practicable, the
9 designated officer or employee of a taxing unit required to post
10 information on the home page of the taxing unit's Internet website
11 under Subsection (e) shall publish a summary of that information
12 and the uniform resource locator (URL) address of the location
13 where that information is posted in a newspaper of general
14 circulation in each county in which the taxing unit is located. This
15 subsection does not apply to a taxing unit if:

16 (1) the taxing unit is located wholly or partly in a
17 county with a population of one million or more; or

18 (2) no part of the taxing unit is located in a county
19 in which a newspaper of general circulation is published.

20 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
21 to an ad valorem tax year that begins on or after the effective date
22 of this Act.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2026.
