- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 11, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 11.0512 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 11.0512. STUDENT TRUSTEE. (a) This section applies
- 9 only to a school district to which Section 11.0511 does not apply.
- 10 (b) In addition to the number of trustees of a school
- 11 district as provided by Section 11.051, the board of trustees of a
- 12 school district may appoint a student trustee in the manner and for
- 13 <u>a term prescribed by the board. A student is eligible for</u>
- 14 appointment as a student trustee only if the student:
- 15 (1) is enrolled in or will be entering the 11th or 12th
- 16 grade and is considered in good standing academically and under the
- 17 district code of conduct; and
- 18 (2) has received parental permission to participate.
- 19 (c) A student trustee is not a member of the board of
- 20 trustees of the school district for which the student is appointed.
- 21 A student trustee has the same powers and duties as a member of the
- 22 board of trustees, including the right to attend and participate in
- 23 open meetings of the board, except that the student trustee:
- 24 (1) may not vote on any matter before the board or make

- 1 or second any motion before the board;
- 2 (2) is not counted in determining whether a quorum
- 3 exists for a meeting of the board or in determining the outcome of
- 4 any vote of the board;
- 5 (3) may not attend or participate in a closed session
- 6 of the board; and
- 7 (4) is not entitled to receive compensation or
- 8 reimbursement of the student trustee's expenses for services on the
- 9 board.
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
