- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 493.0075 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 493.0075. DONATION OF ACCRUED COMPENSATORY TIME OR
- 8 ACCRUED ANNUAL LEAVE FOR LEGISLATIVE PURPOSES. (a) The executive
- 9 director shall allow a correctional officer employed by the
- 10 department to voluntarily transfer to a legislative leave pool up
- 11 to eight hours of compensatory time or annual leave per year earned
- 12 by the correctional officer.
- 13 <u>(b) The executive director or the executive director's</u>
- 14 designee shall administer the legislative leave pool.
- 15 (c) The board shall adopt rules and prescribe procedures
- 16 relating to the operation of the legislative leave pool.
- 17 <u>(d) The executive director or the executive director's</u>
- 18 designee shall credit the legislative leave pool with the amount of
- 19 time contributed by a correctional officer employed by the
- 20 department and deduct a corresponding amount of time from the
- 21 correctional officer's earned compensatory time or annual leave as
- 22 if the correctional officer had used the time for personal
- 23 purposes.
- 24 (e) A correctional officer employed by the department is

- 1 entitled to use time contributed to the legislative leave pool if
- 2 the correctional officer uses the time for legislative leave on
- 3 behalf of an association:
- 4 (1) related to the correctional officer's employment
- 5 with the department;
- 6 (2) that has at least 5,000 active or retired members;
- 7 and
- 8 (3) that is governed by a board of directors.
- 9 (f) The executive director or the executive director's
- 10 designee shall transfer time from the pool to the correctional
- 11 officer and credit the time to the correctional officer.
- 12 (g) A correctional officer employed by the department may
- 13 only withdraw time from the legislative leave pool in coordination
- 14 with and with the consent of the president or designee of the
- 15 <u>association described in Subsection (e). A correctional officer</u>
- 16 may not draw more than 80 hours from the pool in a 160-hour work
- 17 cycle and may not draw more than 480 hours from the pool in a fiscal
- 18 year.
- 19 (h) A correctional officer employed by the department shall
- 20 use time from the legislative leave pool in accordance with rules
- 21 adopted by the board.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
