1-16 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to a study by the General Land Office regarding veterans
 1-19 cemeteries in this state.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. (a) The General Land Office in coordination with
 1-22 the Texas Veterans Commission shall study:

1-23 (1) obstacles veterans in this state face in accessing
 1-24 a burial plot in a veterans cemetery in this state; and

1-25 (2) opportunities to address the operational needs of
 1-26 veterans cemeteries in this state, including locations,
 1-27 maintenance, and other operational needs of veterans cemeteries.

1-28 (b) Not later than April 1, 2026, the General Land Office
 1-29 shall submit to the lieutenant governor, speaker of the house of
 1-30 representatives, and chairs of the house and senate committees with
 1-31 primary jurisdiction over veterans affairs a written report
 1-32 summarizing the results of the study conducted under this Act and
 1-33 providing recommendations for legislative or other action.

1-34 (c) This Act expires September 1, 2027.

1-35 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.

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
